


# What is a Prophet?

- Biblical Doctrine





Prosperity. 1<sup>st</sup> World Comforts (smartphones)





Isaiah 1:1-20






# Repent!

# Idolatry

"Their land is filled with idols; they bow down to the work of their hands, to what their own fingers have made."

- Isaiah 2:8

## Idolatry

"As a thief is shamed when caught, so the house of Israel shall be shamed; they, their kings, their officials, their priests, and their prophets, who say to a tree, 'You are my father,' and to a stone, 'You gave me birth."

- Jeremiah 2:26-27

## Idolatry

- Hosea 4:17-19, 8:1-5 (see 1 Kings 12:25-33)
- Amos 5:25-26 (Jeroboam II)
- Micah 1:5 (Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah)
- Zephaniah 1:4-6 (Josiah)

# God's Law: Justice Defined

Justice for orphans, widows & sojourners (Deuteronomy 10:17-19, 24:17-22, 26:12-13)

Care for the poor (15:7-11)

"Legal" justice (19:15-21)

Just treatment of workers (24:14-15).







### Social Injustice

"For wicked men are found among my people... they have grown fat and sleek. They know no bounds in deeds of evil; they judge not with justice the cause of the fatherless, to make it prosper, and they do not defend the rights of the needy."

- Jeremiah 5:26-28

## Social Injustice

"(4:1) Hear this word, you cows of Bashan, who are on the mountain of Samaria, who oppress the poor, who crush the needy. (5:11) You trample on the poor and you exact taxes of grain from him."

- Amos 4-5



#### Ritualism

"What to me is the multitude of your sacrifices?' says Yahweh; I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams and the fat of well-fed beasts; I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs, or of goats."

- Isaiah 1:11

#### Ritualism

"Will Yahweh be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? ... He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does Yahweh require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness and to walk humbly with your God?"

- Micah 6:7-8




# Ritualism: Fasting

- Nahum 1:15

## Jonah

("Yet 40 days and Nineveh shall be overthrown." Jonah 3:4)

Ezekiel




Daniel



# The Post-Exilic Message

3 prophets delivered their message after the return of exiles to Jerusalem:

Haggai Zechariah Malachi



#### Restoration?

"In the second year of Darius the king."

- Haggai 1:1

"In the eighth month... of Darius."

- Zechariah 1:1

# Post-Exilic Message

"Is it a time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, while this house [of Yahweh] lies in ruins?"

- Haggai 1:4


