WHAT IS YOUR VOICE?

- It is a tool
(*Jam. 3:9-10*)
- It is how we interact with the world
(*Gen. 1:3*)
- It is unique
- It is a gift from God
(*Ex. 4:10-11*)

WHAT IS YOUR VOICE FOR?

- It was made to glorify God
(*Ps. 89:1*)
- It was made to give thanks to God
(*Ps. 69:30*)
- It reveals the content of our hearts
(*Mat. 15:18*)

WHAT IS YOUR VOICE FOR?

- It was not made to engage in filthy talk
(*Eph. 5:4*)
- It was made to build one another up
(*Eph. 4:29*)
- It was made to praise Him with singing
(*Eph. 5:19; Ps. 47:1*)
- It was made to make melody to the Lord
(*Ps. 108:1*)

WHAT DOES SCRIPTURE SAY ABOUT MUSIC?

- It is used to mark events in God's plan
(*Ex. 15:1-2; 1 Sam. 18:7; 2 Chron. 20:21-22*)
- It is used to adorn His truth with glory and beauty
(*Ex. 28:2; Ps. 33:2-3*)

WHAT DOES SCRIPTURE SAY ABOUT MUSIC?

- It is used to express grief
(*2 Sam. 1:19-20*)
- It must not express falsehood
(*Ps. 51:6*)

HOW CAN WE USE OUR VOICES TO GLORIFY GOD?

- By learning to use them better
- By learning to sing together
- By learning the basics of music
- By setting aside time for musical training

TIPS FOR SINGING

- Work with the grain
- Don't try and sound like someone else
- Listen to other voices while you sing

TIPS FOR SINGING

- Experiment with your voice to learn what it can do and to stretch yourself
- Sing with conviction
- Sing from your diaphragm
